Principal's Message.

Welcome back to term three. As the media has made it very clear we may be in for another term of disruption with ill health due to COVID. At this stage the actions, which the department are advising individuals to take within a school setting are the following:

1. If you are unwell stay home.
2. If you are showing any COVID symptoms please do a RAT. We have plenty and will send out some later this week for all families to use if required. The school must be notified of a student's positive test so that we can record their absence while in 7-day isolation.
3. Masks are recommended for use indoors or in crowded spaces, but are not mandatory. We have plenty of them as well so just ask and we can supply them.
4. Masks are to be worn on public transport. This does include the school bus network.
5. Air purifiers are to be operating in each indoor space.
6. Household contacts are required to test negative using a RAT on at least 5 out of 7 days and if over 8 years of age they are required to wear face masks indoors when attending school.
7. Social distance where possible.
8. Those who can get a vaccination booster please do so.

This is not the best way to start a term but if we are all able to follow this current advice from the government then we may not have to go to more restrictive measures that we have experienced in the past. At this stage there have not been any restrictions placed on camps, excursions or formals. So we will be optimistic that the events we have planned for this term and next such as The Great Victorian Bike Ride, Tambo athletics, the Snow program, 3+4 Camp, 5+ 6 Camp and the Formal will be able to run without any COVID disruptions.

Term 3 is a very busy term in schools, particularly those that have senior students. This is the term when we start the planning for the next year working with our senior students around their subject selections. This year this is further complicated by the changes to the later years' program and the redesign of the last two years of schooling.

In the morning some students have been very keen to get to school, which is great, however we do not want students before 8:30 am please as we may not have people in place to supervise them. If this creates a problem please get in contact with me so we can find a solution.

Clearly there is only one constant in life and that is change. As we continue to change and adapt to the next challenge that comes our way please get in contact with us if you have concerns regarding our response.
